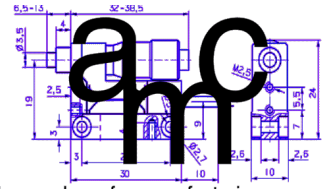

This Baker College degree program is designed specifically for an individual who has already attained journeyman's status as recognized by the U.S. Department of Labor. The individual's apprenticeship training transfers in as his/her major. The remaining course requirements give the student the skills necessary to expand his/her knowledge and opportunities.

To pursue this Associate of Applied Science Degree with a Concentration in Industrial Technology, apply to Baker College a) using their online form or b) by printing out and completing the hardcopy application and submitting it by mail or in person to the Admissions Office at Baker College of Jackson (2800 Springport Road, Jackson, MI 49202). Payment of a non-refundable \$20.00 fee is required to process your application. As part of the enrollment process, after your application has been approved you will be required to provide proof of your Journeyman status and you must complete the COMPASS assessment/placement test to help Baker College determine your skill levels in reading, writing and math.

For Journeymen who have completed an apprenticeship that required 8,000 or more work hours, their prior experience is credited using the following course:

JNYCD100F Journeyman Status 56

For Journeymen who have completed an apprenticeship requiring less than 8,000 work hours, the following applies:

JNYCD100G Journeyman Status 42
